

Dress Code Guidelines 2021-2022

Students do not have to wear a specific uniform to school; however, students must abide by the following:

Skirts and Shorts

The length of skirts, skorts, and shorts must extend below the student's fingertips when the student's arms are extended at his/her sides. Short shorts are prohibited

Shirts

Spaghetti straps, strapless tops, muscle shirts, off-shoulder shirts, and tank tops are not allowed. Clothing that exposes the entire shoulder or bra strap chest or abdominal sides are prohibited

Leggings

Tights, leggings, or other types of hosiery must be accompanied by a fingertip length or longer top or dress.

No Vulgarly

Vulgar or obscene words or graphics on clothing are prohibited. Including masks if required.

No Bare Midriffs

Bare midriffs are not allowed. Shirts cut out at the sides and crop tops are not allowed. All parts of the stomach and back must be fully covered without pulling or tugging.

Keep Undergarments Hidden

Bra straps under tank tops, underwear beneath baggy pants, or even undergarments showing through rips and holes in clothing are prohibited.

No Gang-Related Clothing

These items may include specific colors, head coverings like a do rag/bandannas, jewelry, emblems, or graffiti of any kind. We prohibit any gang-related clothing on school property or at school-sponsored events.

Shoes

Shoes must be worn with socks or tights; no sandals, open toed shoes, open heel shoes, Crocs, or high heels (*due to safety*).

No Hats / Hoods

Hoods or hats cannot be worn in the building (this excludes religious head-dress)

No Costumes

No costumes allowed. This includes, but is not limited to, dressing like super heros, pets/animals, furrries, etc.... Students must wear regular clothing with regular/standard masks.
